ADAIR COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATOR JIM LEBARON AND ADAIR COUNTY OPIOID COALITION COORDINATOR RON STEWART

JIM LEBARON spoke about the 2019 Drive-Thru Flu Clinic to be held on **Wednesday**, **October 2** from noon-6 pm at three Adair County sites - NEMO Fairgrounds, Novinger Fire Station, and on the square in Brashear. Adair is one of the four counties hoping to dispense a total of 3,000 shots that day as an example for the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to consider the program statewide. (The other counties are Randolph, Macon and Schuyler.) This free clinic is a community preparative exercise for a possible pandemic when round-the-clock services are required within 48 hours. Jim said although 2 out



of 3 people 65 or older get flu shots, only a third of younger people get them. He said WHO was slow in identifying the strains this year but as of the end of August he had 750 doses. Flu shots will be available at the clinic building beginning on Friday, October 4. He does not have any high dose shots yet this year but has ordered 330 doses which he hopes to have by the end of September. (The high dose version is not available at the drive-thru.) RON STEWART, a retired fire chief, is Jim's incident commander and is also coordinator for the Adair County Opioid Coalition, formed in March 2018. Ron spoke about opioid addiction, often accidental involving pain relief. He spoke about Narcan which has saved many lives from overdoses. It is now widely available.
