PROGRAM—Kirksville Police Chief Steve Farnsworth

Matt Eichor introduced Kirksville Police Chief Steve Farnsworth. Chief Farnsworth started his law enforcement career in 1986 with the Kirksville Police Department (KPD) and became Chief of Police in September 2019. He reported that that KPD has 30 commissioned police officers and shared KPD annual report statistics showing a categorical breakdown of the 32,935 calls for service during 2019. Chief Farnsworth said that the rate of violent crimes in Kirksville is less than the national average, but the rate of property crimes is higher. He said the KPD plans to implement a community camera program to assist police investigations. More information about that program will be forthcoming. Chief Farnsworth noted that citizens report scams every day, described some scams, and cautioned people to be wary of scam perpetrators.
