Every three years, all 535 Rotary districts worldwide select a delegate as a representative to the Council on Resolution and Legislation. These bodies review and vote on proposed changes to the legislation that governs Rotary. The Council on Resolutions meets online every year to vote on proposed resolutions. And the Council on Legislation meets once every three years. Jeff Romine was selected to serve as the delegate to represent District 6040 at the Council on Legislation to be held in 2022.
