## 2020/21 PRESIDENT ROY NOE'S YEAR IN REVIEW

Roy said he had really good directors who kept him informed about committee activities this year. Our club had many achievements. These include **Rotary Park** improvements, working with **Parks and Recreation** Commission on the Aquatic Center and restroom and concession renovations at North Park. The **Literacy Committee** had Dial-a-Story, Notable Missouri Books, Read Across America program and the Little Library. The **Fly the Flag** project went from 120 flags in January to up to 173 flags now. The Helping Hands Community Service committee assisted with **Bloodmobile** and held **Adopt-a-Highway** cleanup events. In December almost \$4,000 was raised from **Bell Ringing** for the Salvation Army. We have consistently exceeded our monthly goal of 36 boxes of different foods for the **Food Bank**. (In February we collected 217 boxes of macaroni and cheese.) We raised



\$15,247 for the **Rotary Foundation Annual Fund**, representing \$200/average per member, and \$7,000-\$8,000 more for Polio Plus. We donated over \$4,000 (plus a pair of shoes) for the **Shoes for Orphan Souls** campaign. Our donation buys over 500 pairs of shoes. We participated in **World Community Service** projects, donating \$500 for Panama project and \$1,000 for PPE in Honduras. We developed hybrid meetings using Zoom to reach more members during this pandemic year. We worked on the **Playscape** project and received a District grant for a soccer field project. Our **Duck Dash** fundraiser brought in \$4,400, for a profit of \$1,384. Corporate memberships were instituted. We sponsored a **RYLA** participant. Our club earned a **Presidential Citation**. Roy said he will work with Amanda to achieve our two-year goal of **20 new members**. President Roy thanked a whole host of people that helped him in achieving his goals. We gave him a standing ovation for his service this year! (Page 2 includes some photos of club activities for this Rotary year.)
