THE JEFFERSON HIGHWAY

District 6000 (Iowa) PDG Loring Miller, pictured with President Marie, sang for us and spoke about the historic Jefferson Highway.

In 1915, the Jefferson Highway Association was organized to promote the development of the Jefferson Highway. The highway ran from Winnipeg to New Orleans covering over 2,300 miles and going through seven states located in the territory of the Louisiana Purchase. PDG Loring is on the Jefferson Highway

Association Board of Directors promoting the highways influence to early transportation history. The state of Missouri was a significant contributor to Jefferson development and it is the only state on the original route that has two separate roadbeds.
