TRF is built on a solid foundation of amazing programs including Polio Plus, Global Grants and District Grants (the largest three), plus Rotary Peace Centers, Disaster Response Grants, and Programs of Scale Grants. **In summary**, Jeff said when you give to The Rotary Foundation, you help advance individuals and communities, improve health, and promote peace.
