ON SITE MEETING: JASON HAXTON AT ATSU MUSEUM OF OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE

Museum Director Jason Haxton said the ATSU Museum of Osteopathic Medicine which had its beginnings in a trailer staffed by volunteers in 1934 grew to the accredited museum which stands today in the Tinning Education Center. (In July, 2022, it was accredited by the American Alliance of Museums.) Jason has been the museum's director since January of 2001. He said one of the benefits of accreditation is that he can trade with the Smithsonian Institution. He welcomed us to view the temporary exhibit as well as permanent exhibits. He said tours can be arranged for groups of any size.
