Ramey Weichelt provided some background on our speaker, Dawn Howd (pictured on left below with President Ruth). Dawn began working in Truman's Office of Admission in July 2003 after graduating from the

University with a BA in Communication and Music. Taking advantage of the variety

of performing opportunities at Truman, Dawn was a member of Franklin Street Singers, Sigma Alpha Iota (women's music fraternity), the marching band, and TSODA. Dawn continues to be active in the Kirksville community as a member of the Community Chorus and Mary Immaculate Church, where she is part of the music ministry, the Vice President of Home and School and a member of the School Advisory Board.
