A celebration of life was held for the late Ray Klinginsmith on Saturday, Feb. 10 at the Dukum Inn, 11 S. Elson Street in Kirksville. Over 200 people from all over the country attended the afternoon event, including an International Rotary Club president. Klinginsmith, an attorney who once served as president

of Rotary International himself, passed away on Jan. 17 of this year. He was the recipient of The Rotary Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and its Distinguished Service Award as well as many other awards and recognition for his work and accomplishments. Klinginsmith founded the Chariton Valley Association, which provides services to the local developmentally disabled community.
