

LAKESIDE GRILL, CABINS AND MARINA: Manager Ryan Bowen, a long time Kirksville resident, spoke about improvements being made to its facilities at Thousand Hills State Park, one of 800 nationwide sites operated by ExporUS, owned by Peter Nolan. Ryan said they currently have 14 cabins with a ten-year plan to add several more nicer cabins. They have updated after hours sign in and are increasing security. In the restaurant, new flooring has been installed in the two private dining rooms. A new menu has been adopted (see photo below). Kitchen Manager Joshua has added new items including pulled pork possible with a new smoker. They have partnered with an art gallery where displayed pieces can be purchased. He said the showroom is constantly changing. Marina upgrades include \$30,000 ADA and kayak launch improvements. They currently have four pontoon boats to rent and 5-6 canoes as well as kayaks and

bikes. Family-friendly products have been added to the store and prices on various items have been cut to be more competitive. Bowen said the swimming area improvements will take longer than hoped since the State of Missouri has only one construction crew to work this part of the state.
