Nathaniel Holte (left), son of Podiatrist Deborah Holte, is a 2012 Kirksville High School graduate. He received an undergraduate degree in biochemistry. Thereafter, he earned his Doctor of Podiatric Medicine at Des Moines University, a private osteopathic medical school in West Des Moines, Iowa. After completing his residency in Des Moines on June 30, 2025, he moved back to Kirksville and joined his mother's medical practice at 1405 Crown Drive in September. He and his wife are the parents of two children.
