It began in 1955 as the Adair County United Fund, organized by Walter Beard. Six agencies were helped at that time; now it is 10. They are NEMO Senior Citizens Services, The Adair County YMCA, The Salvation Army, Macon Community Child Development Center, Macon Diversified Industries, Hospice of Northeast Missouri, Girl Scouts of Eastern Missouri, Adair County 4-H, Heartland Volunteer of Northeast Missouri Area Agency on Aging program (previously provided by Heartland RSVP) and Scouting America, Great Rivers Council. They also give grants to non-profits. See flyer attached to cover email for details. Mills said they are now at 66% of their \$190,000 goal this year.
