

ATSU PRESIDENT GAYLA SUBLETTE MISSOURI CAMPUS



Dale Schenewerk introduced President Gayla (see intro) who spoke about the Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine (KCOM), the Missouri School of Dentistry & Oral Health (MOSDOH), and the College of Graduate Health Studies (CGHS) which offers numerous doctoral and master's programs. U.S. News and World Report's 2025 Best Medical Schools ranked KCOM first in the nation in graduates who go on to practice in rural sites (31.9% of KCOM graduates). It ranked them sixth in graduates practicing in medically underserved areas (67.7%) and primary care fields (41.8%). Enrollment for 2025-26 is 683. The Class of 2025 had 100% residency placement. A primary clinical education site for third and fourth year MOSDOH students is housed in its three-story St. Louis Dental Center. In 2025 MOSDOH students participated in over 100 community service projects. The MOSDOH dean will be announced later this month.
