



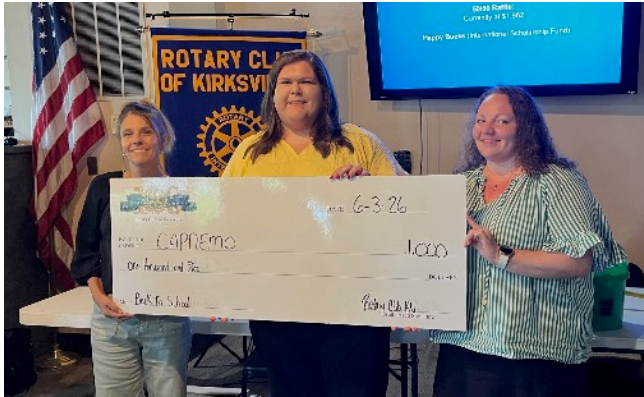

Dan spoke about the project beginning in 1996 and the various grants, Rotary and community support received over the years.
