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NEW KIRKSVILLE REGIONAL AIRPORT:

Jeff LaFountain (pictured), originally from Massachusetts, has been airport director here for three years but he has worked at the airport for 11 years. There is a ribbon cutting today, however, all improvements will be completed by mid to late September. The new airport did not require City funding. As of August 1, they added flights to Dallas in addition to Chicago. Contour Airlines has averaged two cancellations per month, whereas Cape Air had three cancellation/mo. Delays are an issue, mostly out of Chicago. Contour has been +60% on time. Transportation from the airport has been another problem with no solution forthcoming.
