



Centerville Rotary Club 2018 Scholarship Program

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Centerville Rotary Club College Scholarship Program is to assist young adults residing in Centerville/Washington Township in their pursuit of advanced degrees so that they may become our leaders of tomorrow.

AWARD: Scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded to graduating seniors from Centerville/Washington Township who will be attending an accredited four year college; an accredited two year community college; or an accredited trade school. One-year scholarships are awarded based on financial need, scholastic achievement and potential success in their post-secondary education institution. Children and grandchildren of Rotarians are not eligible.

DEADLINE: Applications must be submitted to the High School Guidance school guidance counselor or to the Centerville Rotary Club, Educational Foundation, Attention: Executive Director, P.O. Box 41431, Centerville, Ohio 45411-0431 by Tuesday April 17, 2018. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
