

2025 Scholarship Program

PURPOSE: The purpose of the Centerville Rotary Club College Scholarship Program is to assist young adults residing in Centerville/Washington Township in their pursuit of advanced degrees so that they may become our leaders of tomorrow.

AWARD: Scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded to graduating seniors from Centerville High School who will be attending an accredited four year college; an accredited two year community college; or an accredited trade school. One-year scholarships are awarded based on financial need, scholastic achievement and potential success in their post-secondary education institution. Children and grandchildren of Centerville Rotarians are not eligible.

DEADLINE: Applications must be **submitted to the High School Guidance school guidance counselor by Tuesday April 15, 2025.** Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: All documents must be done in Word Document attachment.

- 2) Two reference letters: 1 teacher or student activity leader and 1 public service or community activity leader
- 3) Short essay stating how your academic and career goals relate to Rotary International goals (not to exceed 500 words).
- 4) Signature form: 1. Student Signature,

 - 3. School guidance counselor signature
