- Organization's need and overall impact to the organization/project
- Participation of Rotary Club members on boards and committees of the receiving organization
- Demonstrated support of and impact on Rotary International and Oakwood Rotary objectives
- Previous and/or potential program or organization success
- Contributions sought from Rotary compared to other sources

Please Note: If the Oakwood Rotary Foundation decides to grant funds, it should be understood by the recipients(s) that the Foundation typically does so on a "one-time" basis. Recurring requests for the same purpose are not encouraged, but may be submitted. Grants for "seed funding" to assist with initial start-up costs are encouraged if the project is to eventually become self-sustaining. Efforts, which may qualify for additional matching funds, are also encouraged.

Oakwood Rotary Foundation Grant Guidelines

The overall goal of the Oakwood Rotary Foundation is to financially assist non-profit, service efforts that benefit the largest possible segment of our community. Preference will be given to organizations conducting projects within the Miami Valley Region, but consideration will also be given to those outside the region, to include our State, National, and International communities, as well.

Giving Areas of Emphasis:

1. Non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization qualification (Tax ID # must be provided)
2. Overall impact to the organization, project, and/or community
3. Efforts where a Rotarian is active within the organization and/or on its board and where that organization advances the service objectives of Rotary International
4. Efforts where "seed funding" assists initial start-up, then the project becomes self-sustaining
5. Projects where funding for a specific, tangible item is identified
6. Projects benefiting children and youth at risk
7. Support for families in need
8. Developing youth leadership
9. Community educational efforts
10. Fostering the fine and performing arts in the community
11. Projects which potentially qualify for further grant-matching opportunities

Funding is typically not granted for the following:

1. Annual operating expenses
2. Programs with similar recurring needs
3. Individuals (as opposed to non-profit organizations)
4. Travel expenses
5. Large capitalization efforts or endowments
6. Oakwood school-related requests better served by the Oakwood Educational Foundation
