## SAN DIEGO OPERATIONS OVERVIEW



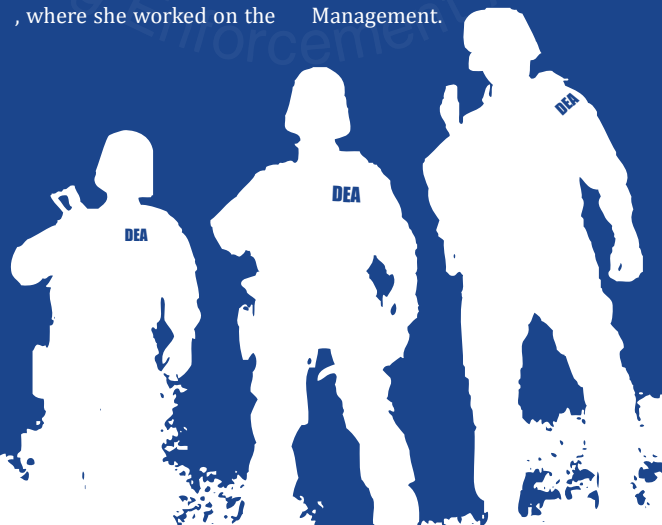
### Special Agent Amy Roderick

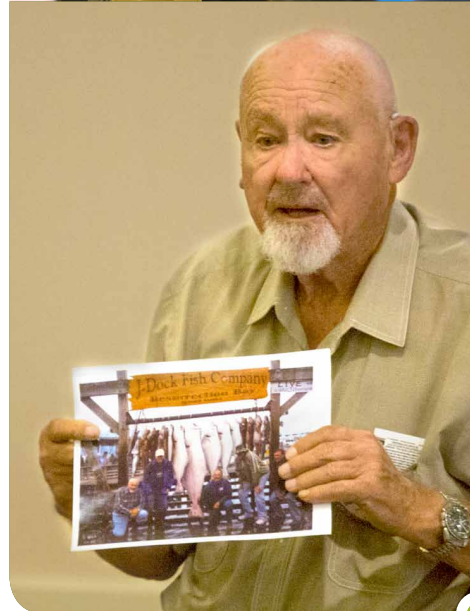

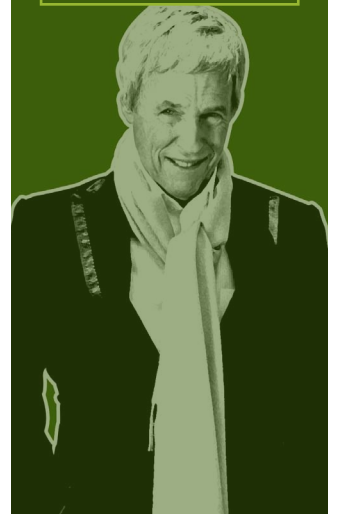

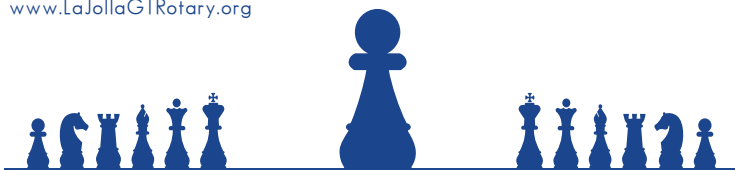
