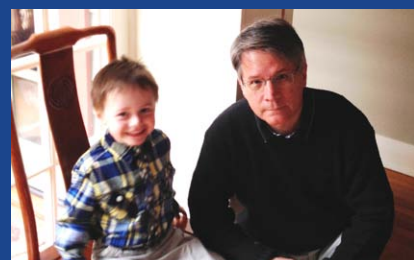


LINDA STOUFFER
