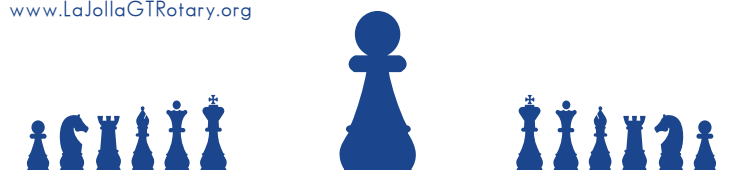

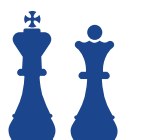

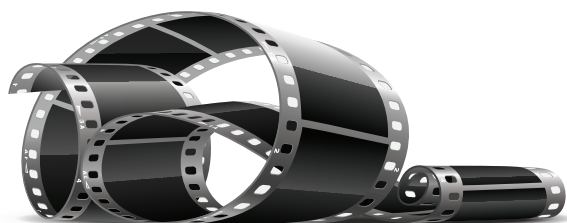

After graduating from a small Catholic girls school in Los Angeles, she chose to go to USC where she graduated with a life long Trojan spirit. Fight On! Kathleen began her lifelong love of travel by doing post graduate studies at the Univ. of Valencia in Spain.

A few years after teaching Kgn and first grade in San Diego she accepted a position with the US Dept of Defense to teach in Berlin.
