Polio Plus Chair, Afghanistan



Mr. Ishaq was born in Kabul, Afghanistan. He received a Faculty of Agriculture degree from Kabul University in 1981. He was Secretary General of the Afghan National Commission for UNESCO, serving on several committees in the mid nineties and was editor of the Pashto edition of the UNESCO Courier.

"Ishaq", as he is known to his friends, has served in management positions in several organizations, such as Mercy Corp International, ARCS, International Foundation of Hope, Organization of Afghan Alumni and Afghan Technology Associates. He has attended several conferences and workshops in the US, Paris, Geneva, Maldives, Pakistan, Thailand, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and others.

Ishaq first met La Jolla Golden Triangle Rotary Club members **Fary Moini** and **Steve Brown** when they were beginning the development of the LJGT Rotary School in Jalalabad, Afghanistan in 2002. For the past twelve years, he has subsequently served as the primary project manager and local contact for the construction of the original school plus an addition, a guest house, the Stephen R. Brown International Learning Center, a dormitory for 72 girls at Nangarhar University and the Faculty of Education Learning and Computer Center at the University. These were all designed by Rotarians in San Diego but constructed by Afghan workers with donated funds under his supervision. The projects have provided venues for the countless on-going education programs initiated by Fary and Steve and assisted by Ishaq.

He served as Director of the SDSU/Nangarhar University partnership, allowing Afghan professors to study in the US and creating a line of communication between the two universities.

Ishaq was the Charter President of the Jalalabad Rotary club, founded by **Steve** and **Fary**. He is currently the Afghan National Chair of Rotary International's Polio Plus Committee and was recently appointed a member of Rotary's Eastern Mediterranean Regional Polio Plus Committee.

He is married with seven children and two grand children and resides in Jalalabad.

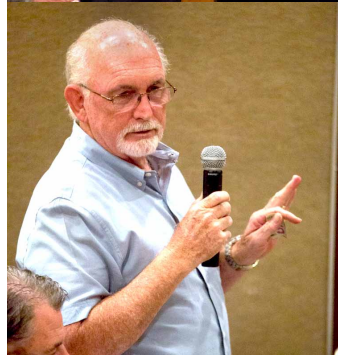

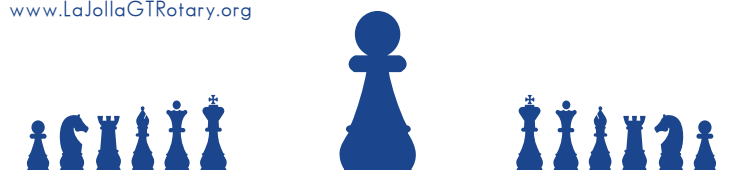

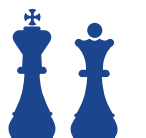

Michael Bardin: charter member of LJGT Rotary, past president, co-creator and still chair of Rotary District 5340 Pathways to Peace and numerous other club and District projects and responsibilities. My link to Rotary goes back two generations. My grandfather was president of Rotary Club #2 in San Francisco in the early '40s. I also was totally surprised when our **District Governor Carl Kruse** presented me this year's District Rotarian of the Year award. Promoting all of Rotary's work as Pathways to Peace truly has become a personal commitment.

Professionally, I am chief public policy officer for Scripps Health. Working out of the Office of the President I oversee Scripps' role in the development of health care

policy on federal, state and local levels. With 35 years at Scripps, I previously headed Scripps' public relations and marketing communications. That was after a dozen years with **Phillips-Ramsey**, then San Diego's largest advertising and public relations agency. I also was for several years a public affairs officer in the Navy serving on the aircraft carrier USS Ranger (with a tour to Vietnam) and a naval liaison representative in Hollywood to the motion picture and television industry.

I am a native of the San Francisco Bay Area – born and raised in Berkeley, and a graduate of Stanford University. (I'm attending my 50th reunion this Fall.) Much of my family is in the Bay Area – mother (97 years) in Moraga,

Sister in Oakland, two daughters and families (five grandchildren) in Silicon Valley. My wife **Arlene** and I will celebrate our 48th anniversary in October. (We met in San Francisco in the middle '60s in the Haight-Ashbury on Halloween night.) I am a fourth generation Californian; my great, great grandfather traveled to California on the Oregon Trail in 1852, settling in the Salinas Valley.
