

WE has funded over 15,000 small repayable business loans for impoverished women in Ghana, Uganda, Benin, Honduras and Mexico, plus helped poor San Diego women launch over 175 businesses and strengthen 100 more.

Poway-Scripps Rotary Club member Win Cox is the Co-Founder of WE and will speak about the WE STAR Center in City Heights, a free business-startup incubator for poor San Diego women. Clients receive comprehensive one-on-one and group session help to bring their ideas to life as sustainable businesses such as licensed child-care, catering, sewing and alterations, hair salons, sales of imported goods, small retail stores, etc.


Ron Kohl's promotion and Brett


