

4 Way Test was developed in 1932 by Herbert J. Taylor.

Hundreds of thousands of cancer patients have been treated with *Rituxan* as a result of **Antonio's** efforts.





Dave Davis was born in and lived the first 18 years of his life in the mysterious cosmopolitan city of Bakersfield, California. Dave is the second of three children (brother Jeremy and sister Faith) born to Joe and Mary Davis in the 1950's.
