Anne Hoiberg

During her 25-career as a Research Psychologist with the Federal Government, Anne published two books and more than 130 scientific articles, book chapters, and reports.

Currently, she serves as President of the following: Women's Museum of California, International Museum of Human Rights at San Diego, and La Jolla Pen Women. She is a past president of the League Women Voters of San Diego, United Nations Association of San Diego, and National Women's Political Caucus. She has volunteered as an election supervisor in "emerging" countries (eight missions) and leads delegations to United Nations' conferences and meetings.

Since 1996, she has organized conferences, published articles, and given presentations on women's rights at local, national, and international conferences (e.g., Cuba, Greece, Uganda, South Africa); she has served on the board of several nonprofit organizations, such as the Bilateral Safety Corridor Coalition and the Nile Sisters Development Initiative. She is a free-lance writer and public speaker on such topics as violence against women, human trafficking, women's political participation, consequences of war, and the United Nations.
