

John is an accomplished athlete winning the Iron Man. In 1985 he had the record for the fastest bicycle land speed record. · · · At age 14, **Denise** was biking and just happened to draft behind a cyclist, who was John Howard. He quickly realized her potential and trained her for several years and she won many titles. They went their separate ways and 23 years later **Denise** called on **John** to help train her son for a marathon. **John** then encouraged Denise to train for this bicycle land speed record which became a 6 year journey. ...
