

Jeffrey E. SeayJeffrey Seay is a retired NCIS Special Agent. He spent more than half his career in the Far East in counterintelligence, counter-terrorism and force protection operations. Seay has the distinction of being the first Personal Security Adviser to the Commander of the Seventh Fleet. He also completed a decorated tour in Iraq, running counterintelligence collection operations in support of the Coalition Provisional Authority from fall of 2003 to spring of 2004. Currently, Seay bounces back and forth between San Diego and Tokyo, having gone back to Japan after his retirement in 2007 to build the security and fraud investigations departments for three multinational firms.

He's a graduate of the University of Southern California in Business Administration and holds a law degree from Whittier Law School. Seay has four novels in his NCIS Special Agent Ruben Carver Series with a fifth in the works.
