Brett announced his plans for a Rotary surfing fellowship! **Brett** is also rounding up his RED SHOE Gang again for June 22.

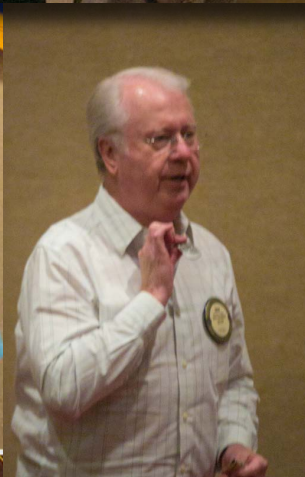

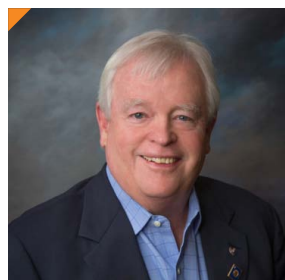
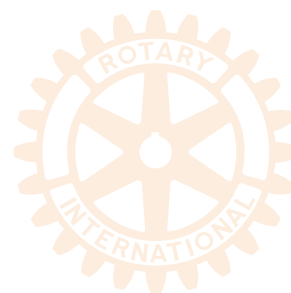
