Key Programs include Mobile Science Lab for Middle Schools: Summer High School Scholars; March of Dimes High School Science Day on Salk Campus; Community events; and teacher symposiums.

The annual impact of these programs show it reaches 3200 students, 200 teachers and 55 schools. 6500 community members act as volunteers and support the programs. Real scientists interacting with students and the one-on-one connection is huge!
