- ✓ Single armchairs can be accepted (depending on current demand)
- ✓ White goods
- ✓ Electrical appliances
- ✓ Microwaves
- ✓ Cutlery
- ✓ TV's
- ✓ Toasters
- ✓ Kettles
- ✓ Lamps
- ✓ Hearts
- ✓ Fans
- ✓ Beds/mattresses (not king size)
- ✓ Bedding/Linen
- ✓ Blankets and pillows
- ✓ Household utensils
- ✓ Small amounts of crockery
- ✓ Cooking equipment
- ✓ Smaller household furniture
- ✓ Lounge suites
- ✓ Dining tables and chairs
- ✓ Bedroom furniture
- ✓ Wardrobes up to 1.5 meters wide
- ✓ Pictures



Please Note:

- All electrical items must not have cords that are frayed, torn or damaged.
- All items must be in good condition, not torn, worn out or dirty.
- WERN and its drivers reserve the right to decline items considered unsuitable for its needs.

✗ What can not be Collected?
