School supplies for school age children  
(Pencils, crayons, erasers, notebooks or coloring books age based)  
One small toy  
Hats, gloves or mitts, socks, etc.

Toys might be jump ropes, balls, stuffed toys, puzzles, dolls, cars not battery operated and no toy weapons. Infants could include rattle, teething ring, blankets, bib, hat, outfit but no diapers. Candy for older children limited to one hard candy (like life savers and no melting chocolate).
