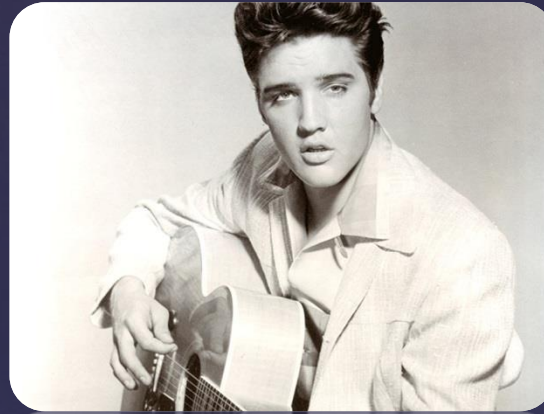
Polio Epidemic of 1952

- 1953- The Farm

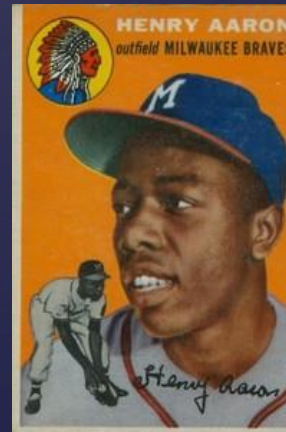

- 1976 – Got married

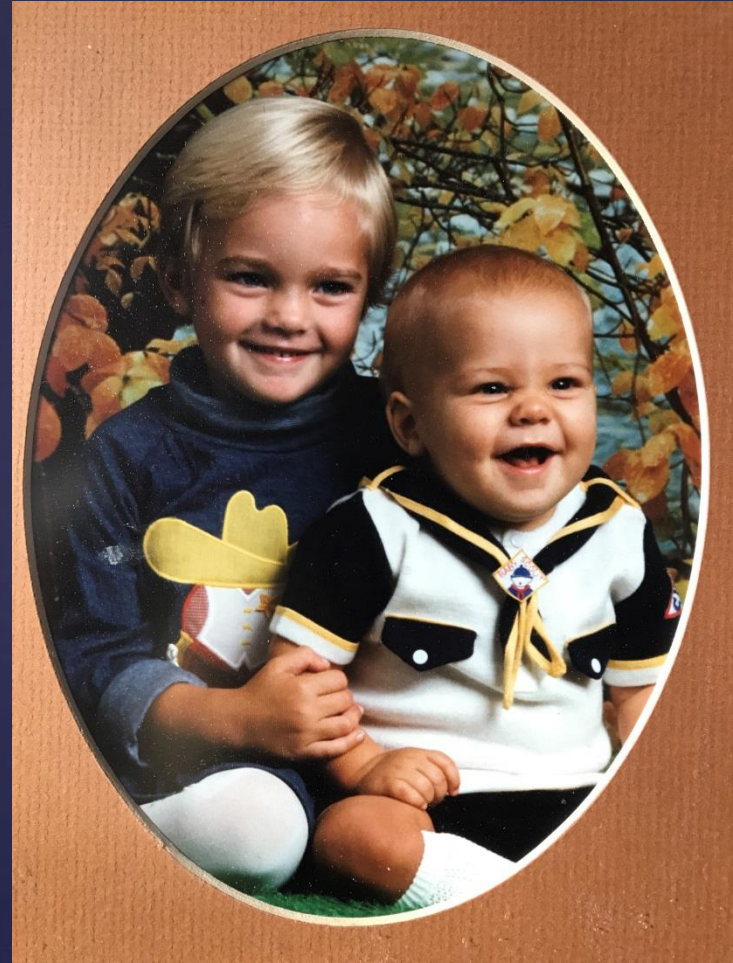

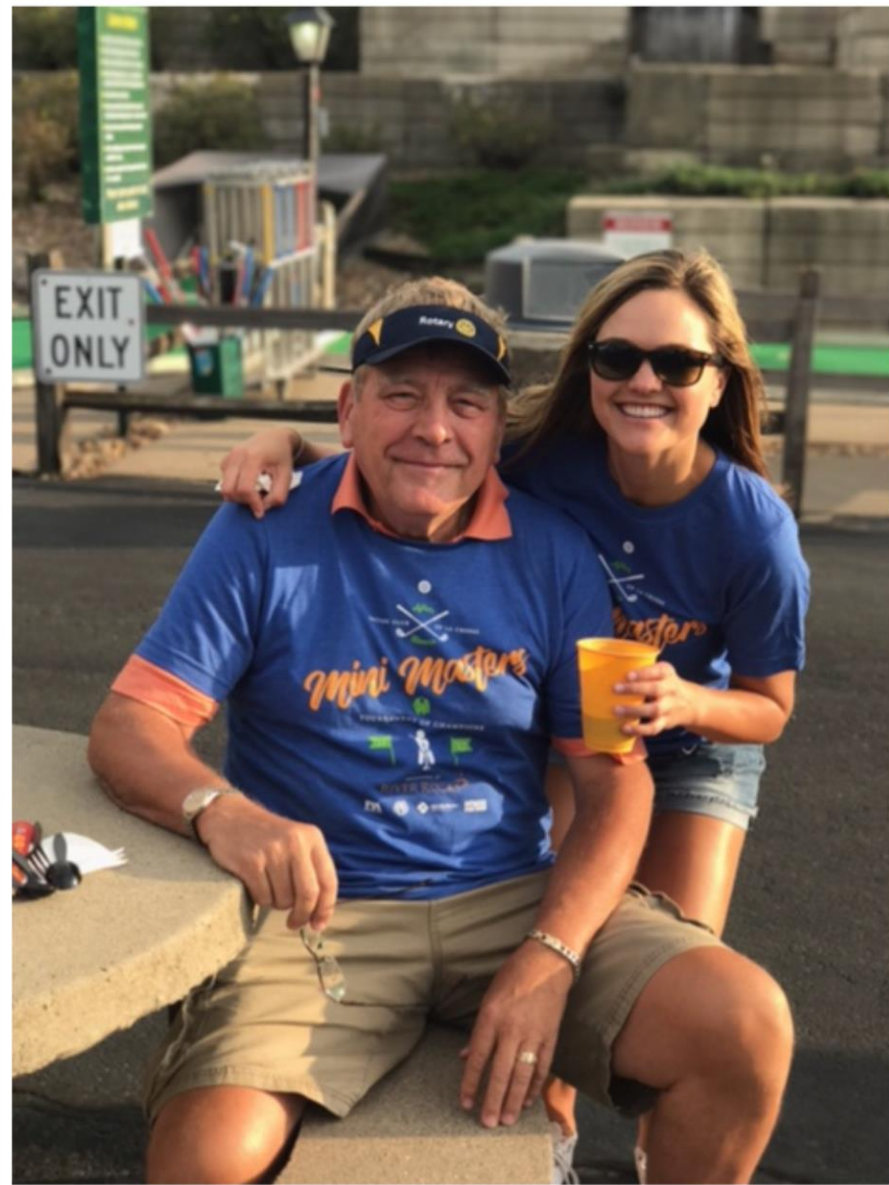
