# Farm experiences: organic and humane practices



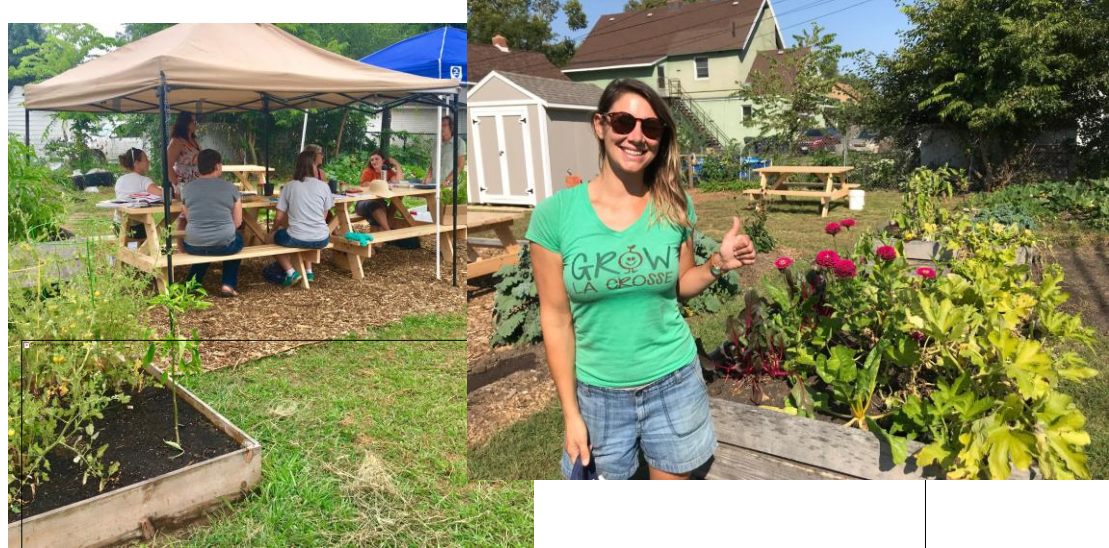
- Cattle, horses, chickens, pigs...
