- Empower people and communities to understand and defend their rights



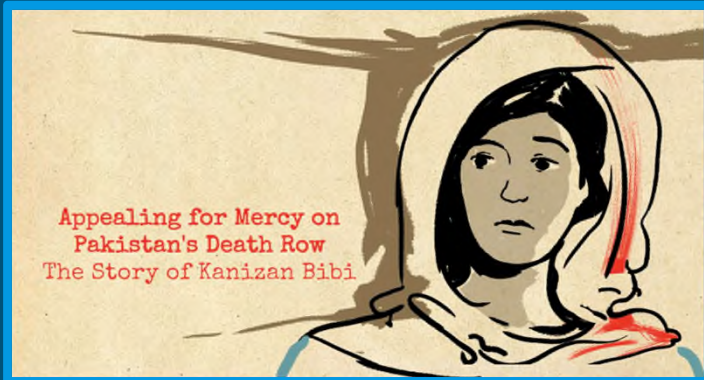


Justice Reform in Pakistan

- Partnership with Justice Project Pakistan (JPP)
- One of the world's largest death row populations
- Disproportionately impacts most vulnerable members of society



Justice Reform in Pakistan



- Campaign to create public dialogue around injustices of death penalty laws and policies
- Videos have been viewed by nearly 1.5 million people in past year
- Government reviewing 27 crimes that warrant a death sentence

Human Rights and Mining

- Produced films in 9 different countries about tactics for protecting community rights:
 - Haiti
 - Democratic Republic of Congo
 - Bolivia
 - Peru
 - Zimbabwe
 - Ghana
 - Nigeria
 - Guinea
 - The Philippines



Human Rights and Mining

- South-to-South knowledge sharing
- Community screenings and radio broadcasts to reach isolated audiences
- Local paralegals provide technical and legal support
