

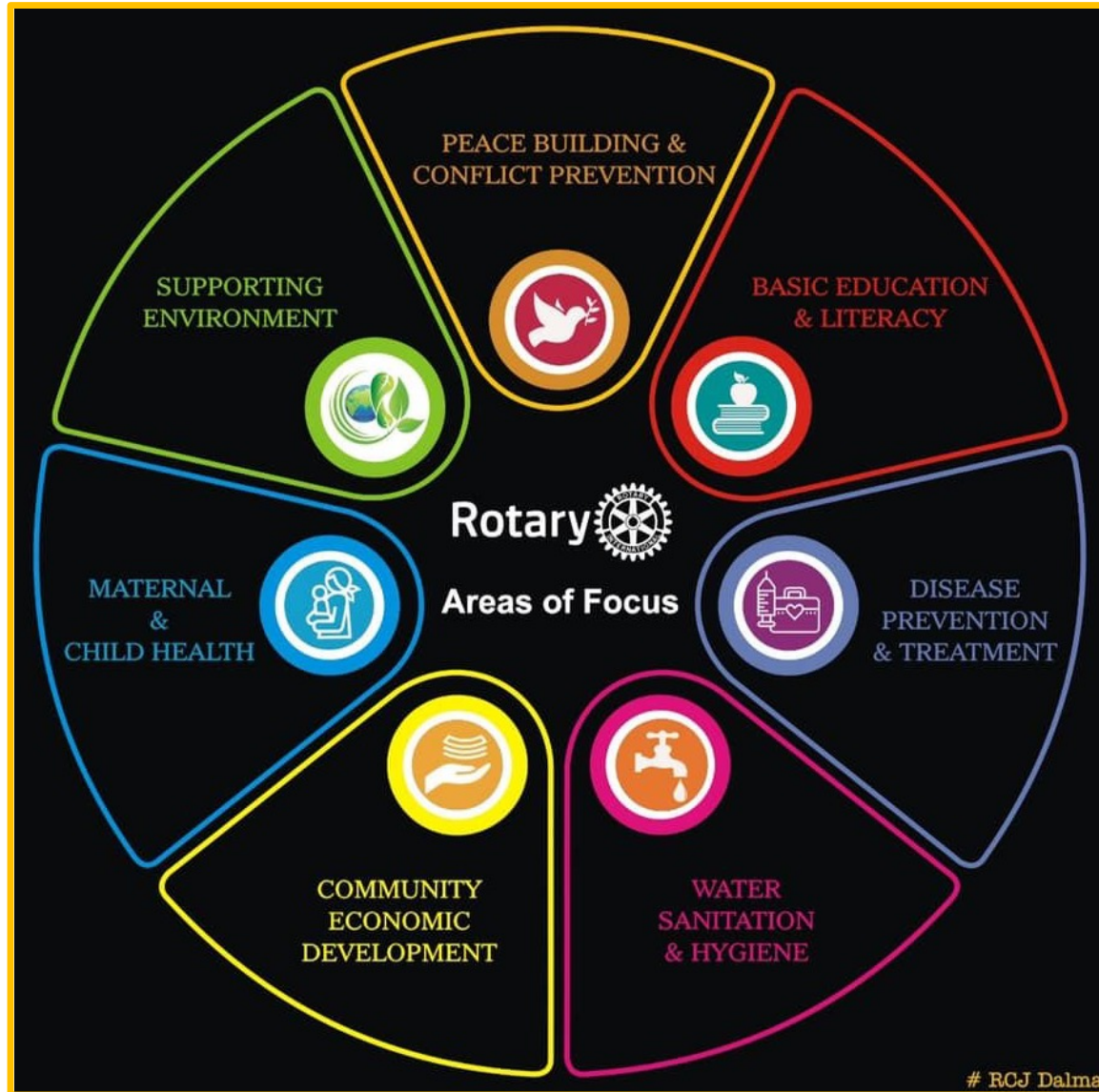

\$85 BUSINESS CLASSES

In the U.S., business classes teach low-income entrepreneurs how to build their businesses.



\$500 ANTI-BULLYING CAMPAIGN

No child should live in fear of being bullied. Your gift helps communities create a safe and positive atmosphere where children can thrive.



\$15 POLIO VACCINES

Polio is still a crippling threat to children in Afghanistan, Pakistan, and Nigeria. A gift of just \$15 helps protect children for life.



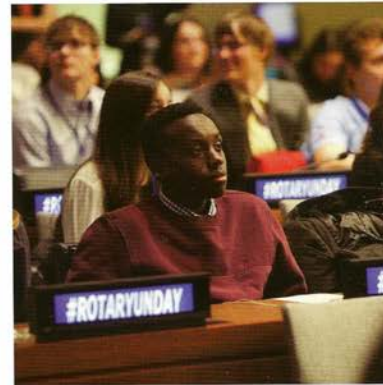
\$100 SEWING MACHINE

In areas where food security is a concern, irrigation systems give farmers a reliable and efficient water source, which in turn helps provide food for the community.

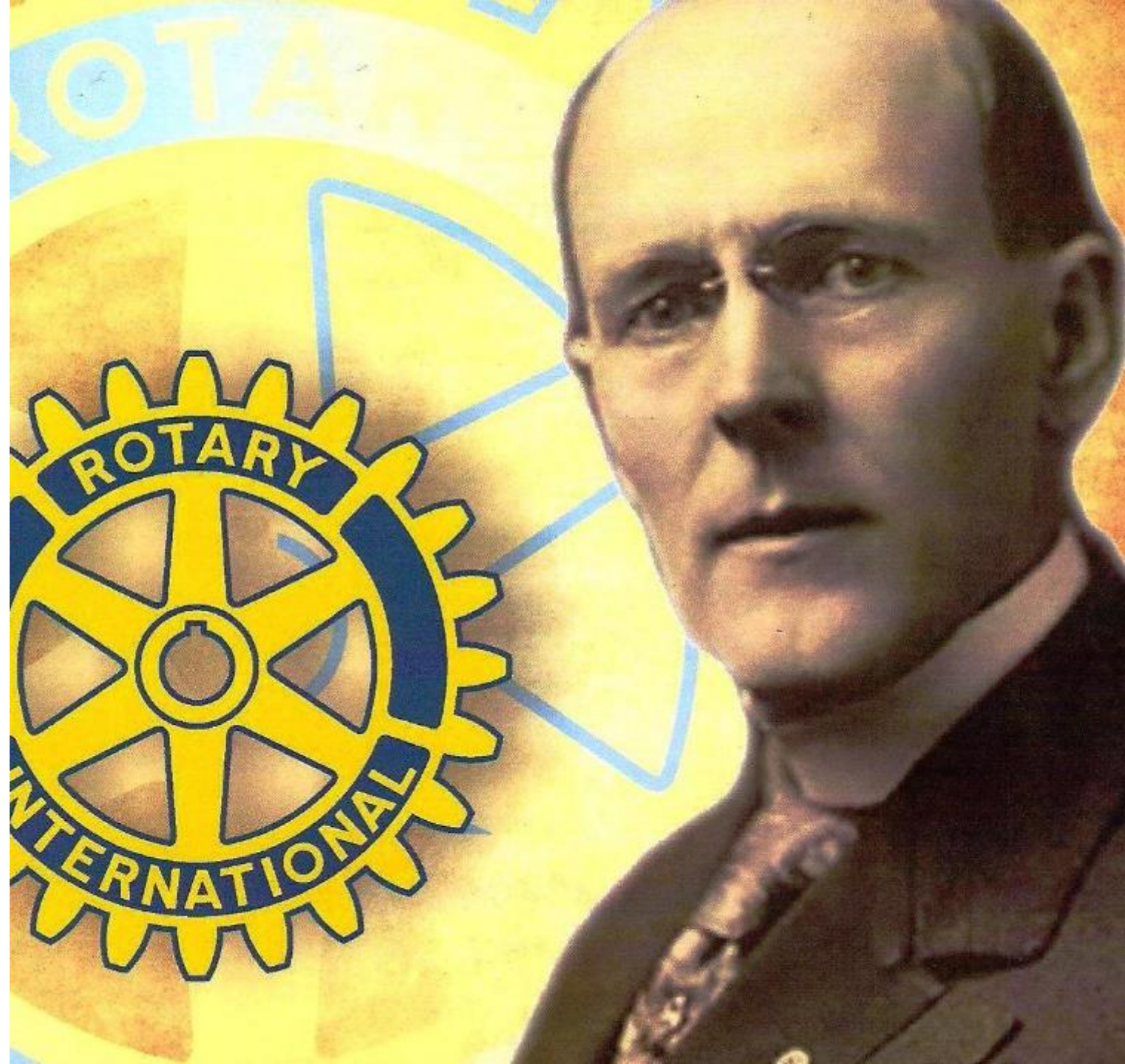

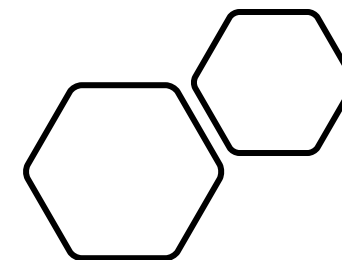
