Above is a preliminary design of what the installed paver layout could look like. The final layout design is subject to change without notification to donors and will be determined by the quantity of donations received at each of the funding levels as well as how the paver design fits within the final layout of the pavement area near the band stand and shell. Placement of individual bricks within the paver area will be final and will be at the discretion of the installer. All of this will be achieved by the Band Shell Consortium Committee in cooperation with the City of La Crosse Parks & Recreation Department and the Park Board Commissioners.

Band Shell Consortium Partners include Explore La Crosse, Rotary Lights, La Crosse Concert Band, La Crosse Jazz Orchestra, Riverfest, and La Crosse Valley View Rotary Moon Tunes.

The preferred logo artwork is Black and White Vector Art. Vector Art files should be exported from the program they were created in as an eps file. Illustrator files saved as .ai files usually import directly as well.

If Vector Art is not available then a good quality Black & White pdf or jpg image will work. Shading or gradients cannot be done with sandblasting which may require alterations to the original artwork. All inscriptions and logos will be centered on all tiles as best as possible.
