WHO WE ARE

Abilities in Harmony provides show choir camps to middle and high school students who wouldn't ordinarily get to experience the joy of singing, dancing, and performing on stage as a part of a show choir.



What is show choir?

A group of 10 to 60 people performing on stage with vocals and choreography often to a themed or story show. Many show choirs are competitive as they compete with 20 minute shows at competitions across the country.

We held our first camps in De Pere, WI and Holmen, WI.

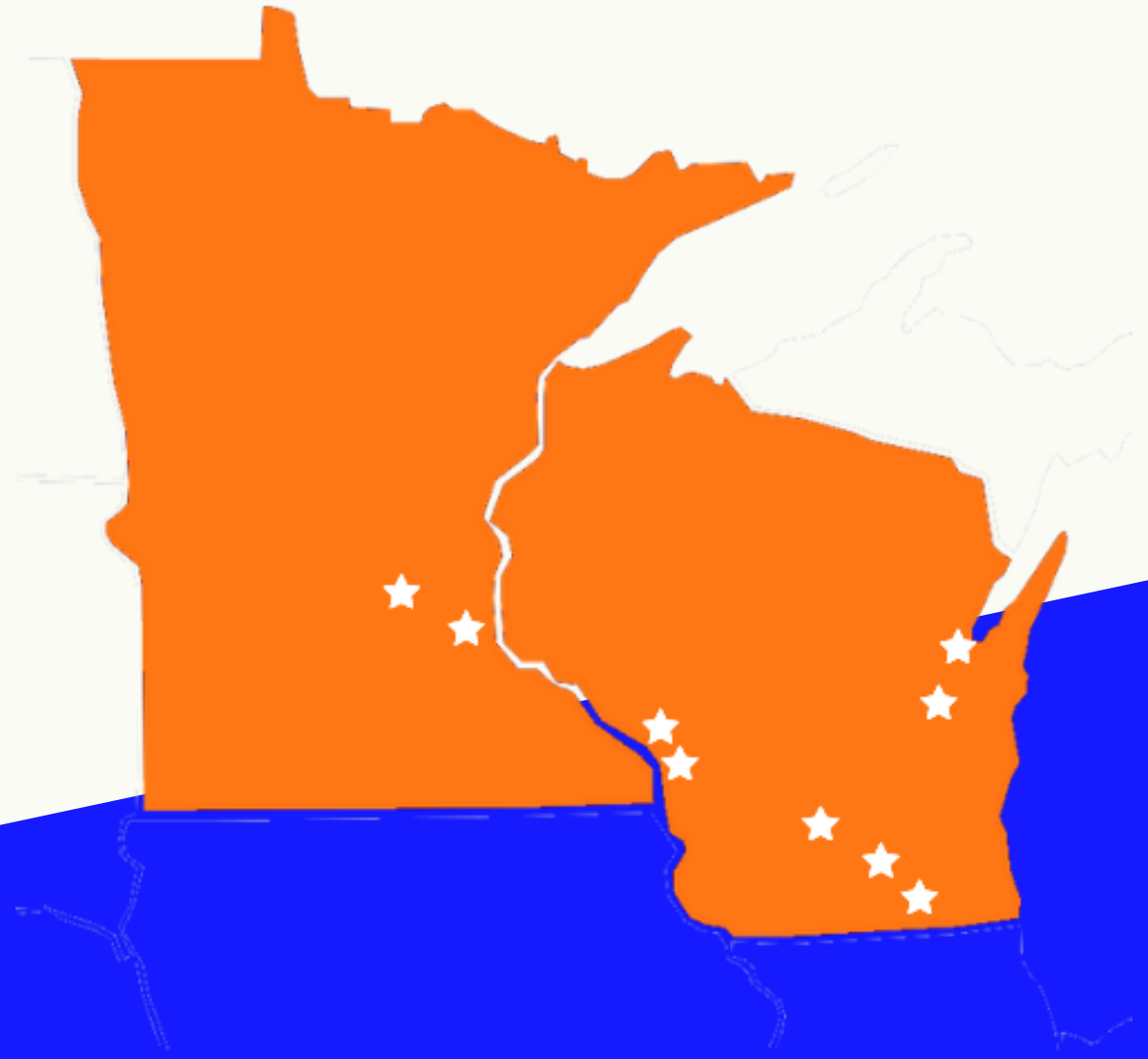


10TH EVER CAMP
