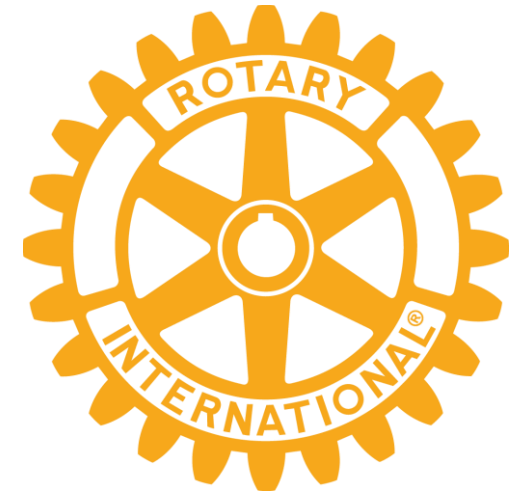

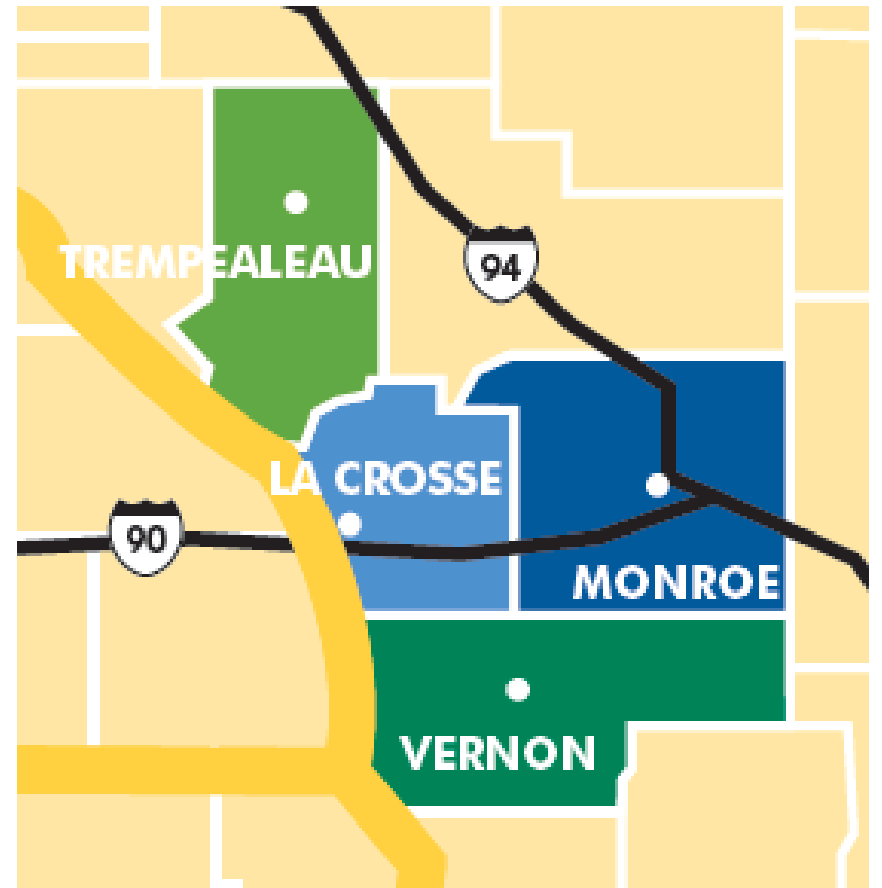

\$ 154,000 26ft base model mobile medical clinic

\$ 76,000 Upgrades to a true family medicine mobile clinic

- 1-2 Exam rooms
- Handicap accessibility
- Lab draw chair
- Medical freezer (insulin/vaccine(s), etc.
- Awning
- Sound deadening (for 2 exam room option)
- Outlet upgrades for medical equipment
- Jump seat (double - additional volunteers)
- And on and on...
