

- COMMUNITY BASICS Access to basic needs







#### Description

Great Rivers United Way is currently seeking volunteers to serve as reading tutors for a new program called **READ TO SUCCESS** that is beginning in the School District of La Crosse this February. Designed with the educational needs of third-grade students in mind, **READ TO SUCCESS** is a one-on-one tutoring program that aims to put kids on a road to success.

The time commitment is one school year, one hour per week with two **READ to** SUCCESS students (two 30-minute, back-to-back sessions weekly).

All volunteers must pass a background check and complete training prior to being assigned their two students. All tutoring sessions will take place at Hamilton Early Learning Center, and volunteers are required to provide their own transportation.


