### Group volunteers-Events Large group participation

- Participate at large planned events statewide using group POC
- Participate with entire group if volunteer numbers allow.
- Participants can be added to the Group at any time
  - Vetting by Group POC
- Ability to wear Clothing with group logo.
- Opportunity to plan separate activities for military
  - USO assistance to advertise on Eventbrite
  - Access to USO logo, and Copyright for USO event marking items.
  - ▶ USO Representative contact to help with initial event planning.
- Full ownership of the event

### Group volunteers-Centers Smaller group participation

- Use of group point of contact about larger events and special needs
- Participants can be added to the Group at anytime.
  - Must submit info for background checks
  - Complete all training.
- Annual participation
- Display desk sign acknowledging the group on day of assignment
- Group selects shifts for the location of their choice annually.
  - Use of 1-2 volunteers at a time
  - Same day of week same time and insure group volunteer(s) are there for full shifts.
  - Know the dates and arrange for shifts at your meetings



# **Group volunteers-Training**

- Receive group training annually
  - Basic USO information training video held by group coordinator
  - ▶ 10 individuals at each session
    - ▶ 1 hours on site at group choice of center with USO representative
- Group point of contact about special needs and operation updates
  - ▶ responsible to disseminate information to rest of group.
- Display desk sign acknowledging the group on day of assignment
- Ability to wear group logo/shirt or clothing at USO.
- Register for center openings annually
  - Known dates times

# Group volunteers - Individual

- Proceed through online training at your own pace (30 days to complete)
- Access to USO Calendar of events, Center calendars, training materials, photos and up to date information.
- Self scheduling for open shifts
- Access to small events, and multiple centers for participation
- Stop and start volunteering at any time
- Transfer to any of 180 centers globally

- Eligible for awards and special incentives
  - Volunteer of Quarter
  - Volunteer of the Year
  - Recognition for time donation
- Invite to early volunteer meetings and social events
- Receive USO shirt and personalized name badge

- Invite to biannual volunteer meetings for elevated skills training
