

The University of Wisconsin-La Crosse provides a challenging, dynamic, and diverse learning environment in which




Measure, assess and create accountability structure for community engagement across UWL

Community Survey: Findings

Community Engagement (Agree):

- Institution is engaged with the community: 82%
- Senior leaders, students, faculty/staff engaged: 73%-85%
- Good job informing businesses and individuals about value to the community: 57-58%

Nearly 6




In 2016-17, students report volunteering through 52 UWL student organizations approximately 9,235 hours of service
