

- We will mute everyone upon entering our Zoom Meeting. We will open the session at 11:30 and meeting will begin at Noon. (You can unmute yourself for the 11:30-12:00 to chat.)
- On the bottom left on your screen.... there will be an audio and video icon this is where you can click to turn on and off for audio and video.






• On the upper right of your screen - you can select - Gallery or Speaker...gallery you will see all participants (you can click on arrow on screen to those that do not fit on one screen) when you are on speaker mode you will see only the person speaking. Once the meeting starts if you want to switch to speaker view you will then view only the person talking.... especially nice to use during announcements and braggers and squealers.


When you are in gallery view – top right will show SPEAKER VIEW. Select SPEAKER VIEW to see only the person speaking. You can toggle back and forth from GALLERY VIEW to SPEAKER VIEW during the meeting.





• Participant icon when you click on that will bring up a sidebar that you can see participants names and the chat bar.






- If you have a ROTARY announcement...please let us know in chat and Tami will call on you.

- IF we have time for braggers and squealers....at the end of the program we ask that you let us know in chat and Tami will call on you....we ask that YOU keep track of your fine for this and when we do start meeting in person, we will ask that you bring your money to our first meeting. We may or may not have time for braggers and squealers.

• Chat icon is at the bottom of your screen...click on.
