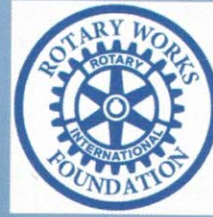
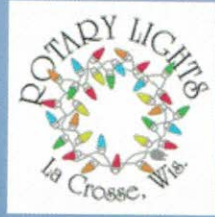
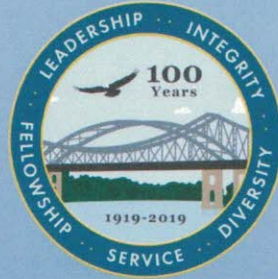

## MEMBERSHIP

**Quarterly Dues - \$76**  
**Quarterly Meals - \$195**

**Active Membership:** Members pay dues and full meal charge.

**Associate Membership:** Members under 35 years old. Pays dues and \$100 for meals per quarter. At 38 they will phase into active membership and pay full meal costs.

**Corporate Membership:** A primary and secondary designee of the business both become members. The primary would pay the dues and full meal charge. The secondary would only pay dues. At the end of the quarter we will tally up the meals of both, if over 13 meals the secondary will be charged for the additional meals.

**Family Membership:** A spouse, significant other, son or daughter may join. One would pay the dues and full meal cost the other only the dues. At the end of the quarter we will tally up the meals of both, if over 13 meals then we will charge the additional meals.

**Excused Membership:** Is a member who has been a Rotarian for 20+ years + age = 85. Member pays dues and only for the meals when they attend a meeting.

**Honorary Membership:** May be offered to people distinguished themselves by meritorious service in the furtherance of Rotary ideals. Must meet the criteria that is noted in the policy handbook.

## CLUB INFORMATION

Meetings are held every Thursday at the Radisson Center, Second and Jay Streets. The buffet luncheon begins at 11:30 and the business meeting from 12-1:00.

**Attendance:** As a Rotarian you are expected to attend at least 50% of club meetings. Regular club meetings of other Rotary Clubs, Rotary events and club committee meetings all count toward the 50% attendance requirement.

**Leadership:** The Rotary Club of La Crosse is governed by a board of directors consisting of seven officers and ten directors. They meet the second Monday of the month at the Radisson Hotel.

**Committees:** We have over twenty committees. You are automatically a member of the STAR Committee-Specialized Training for Action in Rotary. This committee meets for breakfast (complimentary) six times during the year and you may receive a make-up for attending these sessions. You are encouraged to volunteer for other committees that interest you. A list and description of these committees are provided to you at orientation and are on our web site.

**Fellowships:** We have a number of Fellowship Groups that enjoy common interests. You get to know your fellow Rotarian in a smaller group and enjoy your common interest together.
