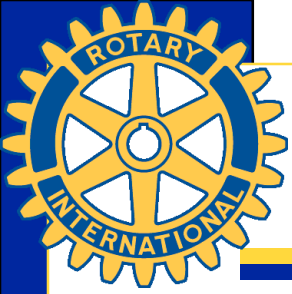

Youth Exchange History

- The first exchanges began in 1927 involving only European students.
- Exchanges between California and Latin American countries started in 1939.
- Activities spread to the Eastern United States in 1958.
- Youth Exchange became an official program of Rotary International in 1972.
- Year long program for 15-19 year olds

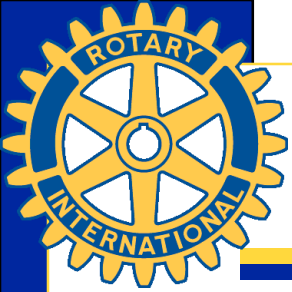




RYE Pop Quiz

- More than 8,000 students travel through Rotary annually, in over 60 countries worldwide.
- Students stay with 2-3 host families and are required to attend school in their host country.

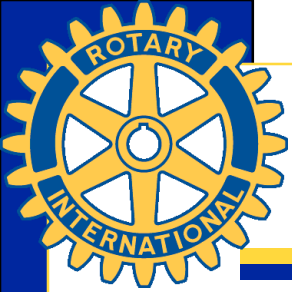




RYE Pop Quiz

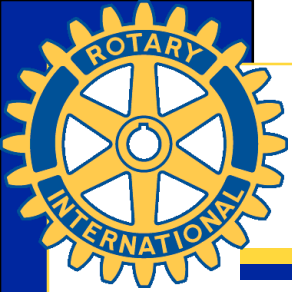

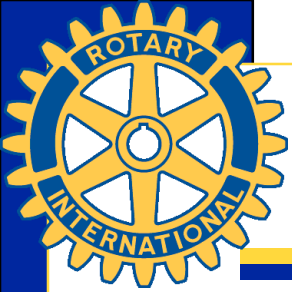




Inbound Introspection
