Yarmouth Police Foundation – The club collected donations during the meeting and the Yarmouth Rotary Foundation will present one check to the Yarmouth Police Foundation of over **\$2,700** in 10 minutes! Guest Speaker - Dr. Kristin Davies from Child and Family Services spoke to the club about mental health. The organization is celebrating 175 years of service, and opened doors on the Cape 23 years ago. At the time, there weren't enough treatment providers, so they opened their doors and also began to do in-home service. CFS works with 80 percent children, who are mostly on Mass Health throughout all of Barnstable County. Currently, there are 60 full time staff members who service over 4,000 Individuals annually.

Dr. Davies asked everyone to imagine driving a car and someone swerves in front of you, you need to slam on the brakes and your adrenaline surges. It takes a while to settle down and be able to focus clearly. She said, "That sensation and feeling is what many of the children we see live with. They are in a constant state of adrenaline, so of course they have a hard time in school as compared to their peers." Their focus is to enter the home to help people understand mental health issues and how to respect and understand how their clients can help these children. Nothing is wrong with them.
