PROGRAM: PRESENTATION OF YARMOUTH ROTARY VOCATIONAL SERVICE AWARD

Sally Bowles, Co-Chair of the Vocational Service Award Committee, in making the presentation of the Yarmouth Rotary's annual signature honor to <u>Calmer Choice</u> and **Fiona Jensen**, Executive Director, read from **Tom Tomasik**'s nomination cover letter:

The Vocational Service Award, named in honor and memory of **Dick Appleton**, is given annually to recognize and award a person or organization for outstanding work in their vocation that improves the quality of life in Barnstable County and inspires others to do the same.

Fiona Jensen, the founder of <u>Calmer Choice</u>, is a Cape Cod resident and Registered Occupational Therapist, and has been a Guest Speaker to our Club in the past. <u>Calmer Choice</u> has successfully provided this primary prevention program to more than 6,000 Cape Cod schoolchildren held at 18 different schools across eight separate school districts since its founding in 2010.

Their mission states that <u>Calmer Choice</u> is a universal prevention program committed to teaching young people how to effectively and safely manage stress and resolve conflict so that they live happy, healthy, and successful lives. Their goal is to provide skills that will diminish the risk of violence, substance abuse, and other self-destructive behaviors. The application of these skills increases emotional well-being and stability. Applied to real life situations, these tools can empower and protect children and adolescents against the negative effects of violence, bullying, and the emotional turmoil that can lead to a host of behaviors that can end with tragic results.

I believe that Calmer Choice meets and exemplifies the qualities for improving the quality of life for our children, their families, and our community. Therefore, I nominate **Fiona Jensen** and <u>Calmer Choice</u> for the 2016 DICK APPLETON MEMORIAL VOCATION SERVICE AWARD of the Rotary Club of Yarmouth. — **Tom Tomasik**
