## The Main Event

David Bernier and Steve Cushing of Weston-Sampson Company spoke on the Dirty vs. Clean water challenges in municipal water resource management., 2) clarification, and 3) disinfection and anaerobic digestion. Yarmouth completes steps 1-3 and a sand filter, and discharges on Bayberry Hills Golf Course and off Buck Island Road pursuant to groundwater discharge permits from the Mass DEP. David awed the crowd by the opaque waste and clarified outflow, compared of all the stages: 1) influent, 2) primary clarifier, 3) secondary clarifier, 4) final effluent with no ozone, and 4) tertiary effluent with ozone filtration. You could (almost) drink it!

The Clean Side – Steve spoke about drinking water treatment and municipal distribution. Water underground in Yarmouth is PH 5.5 on average, which means it is slightly acidic, and is balanced before distribution. There are 17,000 valves, 3,000 hydrants, 17 well and distribution facilities, and 3 holding tanks in Yarmouth, and hundreds of miles of piping. The challenges ahead are PFAs and nitrogen levels, and new technologies are being implemented to protect our waterways and precious underground water resources. We are ALL connected to WATER!!!

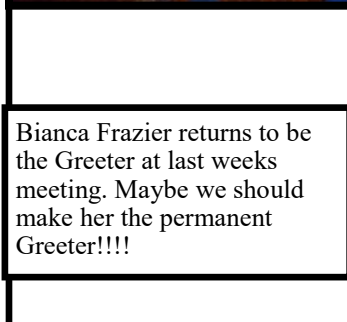
