The Main Event

GUEST SPEAKER: DR. JILL OXLEY

Dr. Bruce Gordon introduced **Jill Oxley, M.D., F.A.C.S.**, with supportive observations of her background and professionalism in the highly regarded and demanding role of surgeons within the medical field. *Background* • 20 years in practice, • medical school: Yale University, • residency: Boston University, • affiliation: Cape Cod Hospital, • specialty: General Surgery, • clinical interests: Breast Surgery, General and Laparoscopic Surgery, Breast Oncology, Breast Diseases.

Additional note: The letters F.A.C.S. (Fellow, American College of Surgeons) after a surgeon's name mean that the surgeon's education and training, professional qualifications, surgical competence, and ethical conduct have passed a rigorous evaluation, and have been found to be consistent with the high standards established and demanded by the College.

Dr. Oxley spoke in terms of “*What’s new in Breast Cancer,*” with subject matter covering statistics, screening and risk assessment factors, DCIS (ductal carcinoma in situ), the Cape Cod Hospital, American Cancer Society, genetic assessments, calculators and life-time risk algorithms & other modalities. She presented updates about the role of the Cuda Women’s Health Center where advanced breast imaging is an important part of comprehensive women’s healthcare. Located in the Wilkens Outpatient Medical Complex, the Cuda Center offers both digital mammography and 3T MRI, a high resonance-imaging unit (the only one of its kind south of Boston).



PAUL HARRIS FELLOWSHIP: IN MEMORY & HONOR OF PETER KROPP
