Guest Speaker – Assistant District Governor Billy Roberts - August is Rotary Membership month and with that in mind, Assistant District Governor Dr. Billy Roberts, chair of District Membership Committee, visited Yarmouth Rotary. He offered his congratulations, as Yarmouth is in top 10 clubs in the district based on the number of members. He said, "When we think about clubs in the district that others can learn from, Yarmouth comes to mind. This club does so many wonderful things in this area and don't just limit it to Yarmouth." Dr. Roberts mentioned that there are 85 members in the club, however, raised the bar letting us know that there is room for improvement when it comes to the number of women in the club as well as members under 50 years of age. He also stated that membership is the responsibility of every member. "More and more we are learning that if every member in the club could think of who they can invite to come to a meeting, the better. Once they are here, they are moved because of the infectious atmosphere," stated Dr. Roberts.
