# The Main Event

Howie Onik introduced his brother Dr. Gary Onik who started his presentation by stating "This Talk Could Save Your Life" and "You are the first group to ever hear this information"

Dr. Onik is a physician and engineer who developed the instrumentation and techniques for focal therapy, a process which allows for the cryosurgical ablation of just the prostate cancer tumor, rather than the whole gland. This initiative is now an accepted alternative to radiation and radical prostatectomy and the preferred treatment for patients with prostate cancer who have failed radiation therapy.

His current research has focused on the development Irreversible Electroporation (IRE) tumor ablation with the "NanoKnife," a non-thermal procedure to treat inoperable pancreatic carcinoma. The modality also holds promise for the treatment of other inoperable tumors including those of the head, neck, and brain. After years of development and refinement leading to approval of the device, Dr. Onik is the physician with the most experience in the world using the NanoKnife, and is able to bring that experience along with the great breadth of his practice in tumor ablation to the treatment of recurrent prostate cancer.

The concepts and techniques he developed have had a major impact on the treatment of cancer patients throughout the world and his work has been recognized by awards given to him by major societies in both medicine and engineering.

In addition to his medical practice, Dr. Onik is an Adjunct Professor of Mechanical Engineering at Carnegie Mellon University, working closely with his colleagues to develop the next generation of cancer fighting technologies.

His final words were: "We have invented a way to give each patient a specific vaccine made from their own cancers"
